Notice is hereby given that the Northumberland County Board of Supervisors (the "County") will hold a meeting on Thursday, May 13, 2021, in the Northumberland County Courts Building (220 Judicial Place, Heathsville), at which it will conduct a public hearing to solicit public comments on the proposed issuance of revenue bonds or notes (collectively, the "Bonds") of the County in the estimated maximum principal amount of \$5,100,000.
