LANCASTER COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES IS APPLYING FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA-R). AWARDED FEDERAL FUNDS ARE MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS)/FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY UNDER THE EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER NATIONAL BOARD PROGRAM

Phase 39-ARPA Funding for \$10,855 is available to supplement Emergency food and Shelter Programs in Lancaster County.

The selection was made by a National Board that is chaired by the U. S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency and consists of representatives from American Red Cross; Catholic Charities, USA; National Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA; The Jewish Federations of North America, The Salvation Army; and, United Way Worldwide. The Phase 39-ARPA Local Board was charged to distrib-

ute funds appropriated by Congress to help expand the capacity of food and shelter programs in high-need areas around the country.

A Local Board will determine how the funds awarded are to be distributed among the emergency food and shelter programs run by local service agencies in the area. The Local Board is responsible for recommending agencies to receive these funds and any additional funds made available under this phase of the program.

Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, local agencies chosen to receive funds must: 1) be private voluntary nonprofits or units of government, 2) be eligible to receive Federal funds, 3) have an accounting system, 4) practice nondiscrimination, 5) have demonstrated the capability to deliver emergency food and/or shelter programs, and 6) if they are a private voluntary organization, have a voluntary board. Qualifying agencies are urged to apply.

Public or private voluntary agencies only interested in applying for Emergency Food and Shelter Program (ARPA) funds may pick up an application at the Lancaster County Social Services office located at 9049 Mary Ball Road, Lancaster VA from 8:00a.m. to 4:00p.m. Monday-Friday (except holidays). The deadline for applications to be received is 12:00 NOON on Friday, July 8, 2022. No applications will be taken after the deadline. (Jun-30-1t)

Field Utility Technician: Water/Sewer Systems Operations

The Town of Kilmarnock, VA is seeking candidates to fill a full-time position supporting our water systems including wells, distribution system and sewer collection system. This role supports Kilmarnock's water utility operations, reads meters, traces utility lines, performs inspections and testing related to wells, and water and sewer distribution systems. Interacts with residential and commercial accounts as well as other utility providers, contractors and inspectors. Role is part of a larger Utilities and Public Works team: other tasks may be assigned to support the team's objectives. Applicants must be able to lift 50 pounds routinely, work outdoors and perform maintenance tasks that are sometimes physically demanding.

Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator
